Subject: Corona virus

The Vail Daily Newspaper today stated Eagle County is now the county with the most cases of Corona virus in the State of Colorado.

Due to the growing concern, Northwoods is taking immediate steps, including increasing the frequency of cleaning to building surfaces and high touch areas in our buildings.

Here are some tips from the CDC to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses including the coronavirus:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- Maintain social distance, put a minimum of 6 feet between yourself and others.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Do not share glasses, eating utensils, water bottles, etc.
